The Thai Language School of Melbourne Inc. is a non profit organisation providing Thai language and culture classes for the Australian-Thai community in Melbourne. The school was established in April 2001 and has been operated by volunteer teachers and staff continuously since then.

Statement of Purpose : To promote learning and understanding of the Thai Language including Speaking, Listening, Reading and Writing. To instil Thai values, morals and culture to learners of the Thai Language

Children's Classes : Kindergarten (Age 3-5 years) – Year 10

The school has accreditation for children's classes from Department of Education and Early Childhood Development since 2004. The school has been approved and granted accreditation from 2010 to 2012. The school curriculum follows Victorian Essential Learning Standards.

Adult Classes : Beginner, Intermediate 1-2, Advanced, and Thai Studies

Private Tutoring : The school has a policy of helping adult students by providing teachers for private tutoring. Students who have missed regular lessons or wish to do extra study can benefit from this policy. Private tutoring is also available if students would like to study during the school holidays. This service is also offered to people who cannot attend the school for normal classes each Sunday. Private tutoring for groups is also available. Details can be discussed separately.

Student Exchange Program : The school has contracts with some universities in Thailand where students can attend special Thai language classes in Thailand. Participating universities are : Srinakharinwirot University (Bangkok), Burapha University (Chonburi), Khon Kaen University (Khon Kaen) and Thaksin University (Songkhla).

Further Education : The school is supported by the Royal Thai Embassy in Australia and is jointly promoting the learning of Thai Language and Culture across Australia, while developing Thai Language into the VCE curriculum.
